



Announcement of the Office of the Election Commission
Re: Policy on Officials Not Accepting All Kinds of Presents and Gifts
From Performing their duties (No Gift Policy)
For the Fiscal Year 2025

As specified in the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand B.E. 2560 (2017), Section 224, The Election Commission shall have the duties and powers to hold or arrange for the holding of an election of Members of the House of Representatives, a selection of Senators, an election of members of the local assembly and local administrators and a referendum to proceed in an honest, just and lawful manner and as specified in the Master Plan Under the National Strategy (B.E. 2566 – 2580) (2023 – 2037) (Amendment) Point (21) on Anti-Corruption and Misconduct with the aims to promote transparency in the public sector and to be free from corruption and misconduct.

To accordingly reinforce working cultures and the values of honesty in working with morality and without conflicts of interests or seek any benefits from performing duties, the Office of the Election Commission has established the policy that the Office of the Election Commission shall perform its duties with integrity and be an agency with all officials not accepting all kinds of presents and gifts from performing their duties (No Gift Policy) in all occasions. The executives, officials, and staffs of the Office of the Election Commission shall strictly comply with the policies thereof.
